

# Criteria for requesting support from ASF

Architecture Sans Frontières international, June 2024



Architecture Sans Frontières International only processes requests for support that meet the below criteria. Please read the criteria carefully before submitting a request.

1. Architecture Sans Frontières International (henceforth “ASF-int”) is a network organisation created to support national member organisations worldwide. These national member organisations are hereafter referred to as “ASF-members”. A complete list of member organisations, of which the majority is called “Architects Without Borders [country]”, can be found via the ASF-int website [here](#).
2. ASF-int does not undertake any project-related activities but the national ASF-members do. By requesting support via ASF-int you agree to us forwarding your request to all ASF-members, who may or may not get in touch with you depending if they have capacity and are able to contribute meaningfully.
3. Depending on ASF-members field of expertise, which varies from member to member, they may offer various types of support, but most often it will be in the form of voluntary architectural services.
4. ASF-members are not philanthropic foundations and none of them directly offer financial support for projects. However, at times support rendered by ASF-members may include funding.
5. We do not accept requests from individuals who do not represent an organisation.
6. From the time of submitting a request you can expect an answer within a month, either from an interested ASF-member who will engage in dialogue around a future collaboration, or in the case no ASF-member is interested, a reply from ASF-int.
7. You are free to reach out to any specific ASF-member organisation to solicit for support. You can see what they work with and find their contact information via the link in point 1.
